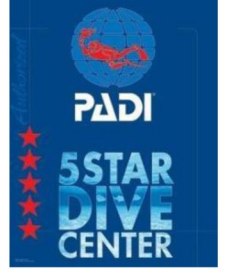

Dates:

Prerequisites:

- 18 years old or older
- 100 Logged Dives (with documented experience in night, deep and navigation)
- PADI Divemaster or equivalent from another training organization
- Current CPR/First Aid within last 24 months
- Certified diver for at least 6 months
- Physical within last 12 months
- EFR Instructor prior to submitting application

Cost/Fees:

- IDC Tuition: \$1095*
- IDC eLearning \$325 (all candidates must do the online portion)
- Materials: \$540 (retail is \$721)
- PADI Application Fee: \$132 (paid directly to PADI)
- PADI Instructor Exam (IE): \$525 (paid directly to PADI)

- EFR Instructor Tuition: \$250
- ERR Instructor Materials: \$199 (retail \$279.85)

IDC Staff Instructor Tuition: \$595 for HOS Instructional Staff, \$795 for non-staff
